- Due to the fact that boarding brings many animals together in a confined space, the transmission of contagious diseases is always a possibility. Pets transmitting these diseases, especially those of a viral nature, are not ill at the time, but are asymptomatic carriers. Some of these diseases like parvovirus can be very serious, even causing death; others like tracheobronchitis cause a persistent cough, which usually lasts 10-12 days. Our stainless steel cages and sealed cement runs are disinfected daily.
- All pets boarding must be current on all required vaccinations, fecal parasite test within the last six months, and annual exam. This includes Rabies, DAP, and Bordetella for dogs and Rabies and FPRC for eats.
- All pets boarding must be free of fleas and ticks. Pets found to have fleas or ticks will be treated at the owner's expense.
- If your pet experiences any mild digestive issues while boarding, Edina Pet Hospital will monitor and treat as necessary, and inform you of any issues when you pick up your pet.
- For any condition other than a minor problem, Edina pet Hospital will provide medical treatment and an attempt will be made to contact you at the emergency number you have provided us.

Therefore, we are asking you to sign this release, stating that you have read the above paragraph and understand the risks involved in boarding your pet. Also that you will: 1. Not held us legally or financially responsible should your pet contract any disease while staying at our hospital, 2. Give us permission to diagnose and treat your pet's illness should he or she become ill while staying at our hospital, 3. Be financially responsible should your pet become ill, and in our opinion, require diagnostic work and treatment while at our hospital, 4. BE ALSO AWARE THAT PET CAN ONLY BE PICKED UP DURING HOURS STATED ABOVE, 5. Authorize any procedures deemed necessary.
